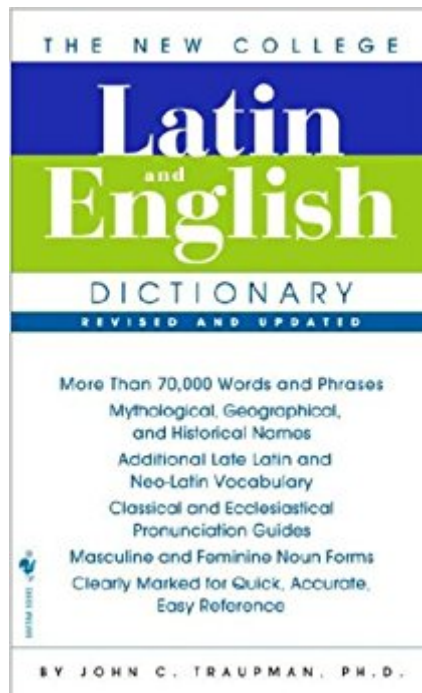

I also own the Oxford Latin Dictionary, so I thought it would be fun to compare the entry for "litus -oris" between the two references. For anyone who is curious why I own a five dollar Latin dictionary when I own a four hundred dollar Latin dictionary, it is because the five dollar Latin dictionary is quick to use. The four hundred dollar Latin dictionary is for purposes of precision in senses of the word. You'll see what I mean below.
